### **Vision Statement**

## **PMI Leadership Experience**

It has also helped to uplift the skill set and knowledge of the PM professionals, and increased more values to our chapter members in the ongoing professional continuous education. I have been resourceful in engaging different trainers to provide a variety of courses that are of value to our members and non-members.
