



# Special Seminar after AGM - "How to set-up project management process in an early-stage startup?" by Mr. Hugues Hallot

A special seminar was organized after the AGM. Our distinguished guest speaker, Mr. Hugues Hallot delivered his presentation to our members on "How to set-up project management process in an early-stage startup?". Hugues has more than 13 years of experience in management consulting and had led the projects of a blockchain start-up and its incubation hub. He is now investing in early-stage start-ups for the fully funded venture capital arm of a single-family office in Hong Kong.

During the sharing, members were introduced to the specificities of a startup environment regarding project management, and how to maximize the value of the organization with project management. Mr Hallot also shared the similarities between startup projects and corporate projects. They come out with a better understanding of how to address their work in a startup context, whether they had planned a carrier shift or want to learn how to better interact with startups.

### 5. PMI HK Chapter Member Gathering 2023




#### 6. PMI HK Chapter Seminars on 26 Sep 2023
